TOMBSTONES THAT ARE NO LONGER EXTANT

*ERBEN, Emma Marie – Rudisleben, Germany: “Town” Cemetery

*ERBEN, Fritz – Rudisleben, Germany: “Town” Cemetery

These tombstones no longer exist in the cemetery, as is typical in German cemeteries for tombstones and graves to be removed after the “lease” period is over, usually 20 or 30 years.

*KASTNER, Robert – Kudowa-Czermna, Poland: St. Batholomew Cemetery

Many cemeteries in the former German region of Silesia have been cleared and all tombstones removed so that new burials can take place. Some old tombstones do remain, however, the one for Robert was not located.

*PREISLER, Emilie – Teplice, Czech Republic: Jewish Cemetery

This cemetery has suffered from vandalism over the years and during WWII. The tombstone base is all that remains of the grave marker for Emilie

*GOLDMAN, Bertha – Detroit, Michigan: Beth Olam Cemetery

No tombstone was found and it is possible that one was never placed on the gravesite as her death occurred just after her parents came to the US in 1902

*HONNEMICHL, Max Leopold – Mucheln, Germany: “Town” Cemetery

*HONNEMICHL, Anna Luise – Mucheln, Germany: “Town” Cemetery

These tombstones and graves were removed in 1998 as is the practice in German cemeteries

Generations of GOLDMAN and MICHALSKI Family members are buried in the old and new Jewish cemeteries in Gostynin, Poland. These sites were completely destroyed during WWII.

Generation of LEJBA and KAUFMAN Family members are buried in the Jewish cemeteries in Skepe and Dobrzyn nad Wisla, Poland. These cemeteries no longer exist having been destroyed by the Nazi's

Many generations of BAUCH, KOLLER & SCHOR Family members are buried in the Jewish Cemetery in Sobedruhy, Czech Republic. Most of the tombstones are in Hebrew and not all remain. The cemetery suffered damage in 1938, during the war and under Communist rule. Restoration of the cemetery is planned as it is a historical & cultural landmark.

The St. Michael's Catholic Cemetery in Lewin-Kłodzki, Poland contains the burials of many generations of KASTNER, WELZEL, ULLRICH and related family members. This cemetery, located in the former German region of Silesia was cleared for new burials. Some older tombstones do still exist, though none for direct family were located.
